EDUCATION, ADVOCACY, REFERRAL AND INFORMATION

SERC responds to all requests for information and presentations on seizures, tailoring responses and training to be both audience and age appropriate to the requesting organization, group, family or individual.

We provide advocacy services for people with seizures in two ways. We provide contact and referral to information and services. We also focus on listening and sharing with those who experience the challenges that come from living with seizures.

We are currently developing Computer Based Training (CBT) modules that cover both the physical and social aspects of seizures for professional organizations.

CULTIVATING FELLOWSHIP

One of the difficulties that people with seizures face is the daunting number of organizations and agencies that provide various services – education, transportation, medical, employment and more.

SERC assists in navigating through these mazes of information and services. Our goal is not to set the path but to assist people in finding their way through the morass by supporting and assisting so that they are able to travel it more successfully.

RIGHTS AND DIGNITY

People with neurological conditions are sometimes subjected to dehumanizing prejudice and discrimination from individuals and institutions within our society – including education, law enforcement and even the medical community.

Through support of the individual and education in the community, SERC advocates for the realization of the rights and dignity of people with neurological conditions.

CONFERENCES AND EDUCATIONAL EVENTS

Consistent with the educational and advocacy aspects of our mission, the focus of SERC events is on the often-neglected issues of the lived experience and social aspects of seizure disorders.

In addition to our own educational and social networking events, we welcome invitations to participate in other local and regional events.
